Education and Care National Regulations 2011- Regulations 102B requires a transport risk assessment to be conducted before Bug-A-Lugs transports any child. Regulation 102D requires Bug-A-Lugs to receive written authorisation to transport children. Bug-A-Lugs has completed a risk assessment to identify and assess any risks that the transportation of a child may pose to the safety, health and wellbeing of the child. This has been authorised by the Approved Provider, Julie Clapham, and is available to sight at Bug-A-Lugs. Policies and procedures for transporting children are also available to view.

Regular transportation means the transportation by Bug-A-Lugs or arranged by Bug-A-Lugs of a child being educated and cared for by the service, where the circumstances relevant to a risk assessment are substantially the same for each occasion on which the child is transported. An authorisation is only required once in a 12-month period.
